Bringing together members from North and South America, Europe, the Middle East and Asia, the Alliance unites organisations that share one belief: music education should be accessible to everyone.



The Music Man Project supports an extensive network of regional teaching hubs across the UK and has reached communities thousands of miles away in South Africa, India, Nepal, Italy, Jordan, Canada, the USA and the Philippines. Each Regional Music Man Project is licensed free of charge, giving local leaders access to original music, resources and performance opportunities designed specifically for musicians with learning disabilities.



The Music Man Project will make its Broadway debut at The Town Hall in New York on 7 October 2026. Written and produced by David Stanley, Music is Magic on Broadway: The Story of The Music Man Project will be performed by the world-famous Music Man Project Global Ambassadors in memory of the charity's late President, Sir David Amess. The Music Man Project will also return to the Royal Albert Hall next year.
